I. The following information is provided in response to questions submitted by potential offerors:

1. The student accident loss reports from Chubb have 'xxx' in the Premium and Incurred Loss columns. If you do not want to share the historical premium, that is fine, but we need the total loss numbers for the last 4-5 policy years or no carrier will quote the coverage. Can you please provide an updated report with the actual data from the 'Incurred Loss' column?

KCTCS Response: Please see Attachment 13 - Student Accident Loss Run spreadsheet.

The loss reports for the student accident coverage, as well as the RFP documentation, state that Chubb is the carrier for the plan. The master policy looks to be a United States Fire Insurance Company, a separate carrier. Did the plan move carriers for 2017-18?

KCTCS Response: Chubb is our current carrier for student blanket accident. The United States Fire Insurance Company was not bound in coverage. Please see Attachment 14 – Special Risk Ins Program and Attachment 15 – Renewal Endorsement.

2. The loss runs released for the Student Accident are Chubb loss runs yet the policy that was provided was United States Fire Insurance Company, which is not a Chubb owned company. We also wanted to point out that the losses on the loss run have all been x'd out so there is not really any information provided, which will be required by any other carrier in order to submit a bid. Would it be possible to receive complete loss runs for this line of coverage that show individual loss information by claim?

KCTCS Response: Chubb is our current carrier for student blanket accident. The United States Fire Insurance Company was not bound in coverage. Please see Attachment 13 - Student Accident Loss Run spreadsheet.

All other terms, conditions & specifications remained unchanged.
